About the training programme

We are pleased to invite you to a training and capacity-building week about the social responsibility of universities and the approach of service learning, which will take place in the premises of the University of Barcelona.

The five-day training with approximately 35-45 participants will be held from Monday July 18th to Friday July 22th 2016, and will involve both input about social responsibility in the university context as well as practical analysis of good practice examples of how universities can manage their social responsibility and have an impact on local businesses, the community and society as a whole.

Some extra information

The University of Barcelona organises the student training in the framework of our International Summer School http://www.ub.edu/internationalsummerschool/. A certificate of attendance with the logo of the University of Barcelona will be distributed on the last day of the training (on condition that students attend at least 80% of the total hours of the training). The certificate will be free of charge.

On the first day of the training each participant will receive a welcome package (a pencil, a folder, sheets, handouts etc.).

At the University of Barcelona the training can also be accredited with ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). The ECTS are distributed as follows: 30 h course: 3 ECTS. Each sending university from Austria, Slovenia, Romania, Ireland, Portugal and Spain has to decide on this policy matter.

Students are responsible on their own for booking hotels/hostels and their flight, <u>for keeping all tickets and all receipts</u> and to hand them in at <u>katharina.resch@univie.ac.at</u> after the trip by July 31st. Reimbursements are made after the trip.

Reimbursement of costs

Costs for the summer school can only be reimbursed if students attend the whole week from Monday to Friday. Costs for the return flight to Barcelona can be max. 275 €. Costs of stay including hotel/hostel, food and drinks are max. 55 € per day per student. Per student not more than a total of 550 € can be reimbursed.

- Eucaliptus square (Barcelona neighbourhood of Torre Baró). Visit to the headquarters of the UB Solidarity Foundation in the Nou Barris district. Presentation of different projects included in the socio-educational intervention programme in the area.
