Application

I hereby apply for the Postgraduate Program *International Law* as indicated:

- Master of Laws (LL.M.) full-time Start: winter term 20____/20____
- Master of Laws (LL.M.) part-time Start: winter term 20____/20____

My application is binding. The tuition fee for the Postgraduate Program *International Law* (*Master of Laws, 2 semesters full-time, 4 semester part-time, 60 ECTS*) is € 12.000,- (incl. students' union fee for 2 or 4 semesters). For additional semesters (beyond the standard period of study) the regulation of the University of Vienna applies. In the Postgraduate Program *International Law* one semester of tolerance is granted with no additional fees. For each following semester an additional tuition fee (incl. students' union fee) is to be paid. In order to apply for the program an application fee of € 50,- has to be paid to the account indicated in this form (below). This application fee, as well as travel, accommodation, subsistence expenses and expenses for teaching material (books, lecture notes, etc.) are not covered by the tuition fee. The tuition fee is exempt from value-added tax. All bank charges incurred for remitting the tuition fee are covered by the applicant.

The number of places is limited. Admission to the Program is subject to available places, time of application and applicant's qualifications. The basis is the curriculum as published in the University Gazette in its respective valid edition.

Once the applicant has been accepted to the program a down payment of € 1.200,- upon receipt of the acceptance letter will be due 3 weeks after receipt.

- Full-time students will further pay the tuition fee in two installments: € 2.800,- by the 1st of July and € 8.000,- by the 1st of October.
- Part-time students will further pay the tuition fee in three installments: € 2.800,- by the 1st of July and € 2.000,- by the 1st of October for the first year. The remaining € 6.000,- for the second year are to be paid by the 1st of October of the following year.

The cancellation of the application has to be submitted in writing (E-Mail AND letter). Within three weeks after the letter of admission was issued, the cancellation will be exempt of charges. After this period, a cancellation is possible until no later than six weeks before the start of the Program. In this case, the cancellation fee amounts to 10% (€ 1.200,-) of the tuition fee. After the beginning of the Program the cancellation fee will be 100% of the tuition fee and outstanding payments are still to be paid. In case of a withdrawal or a premature ending of the postgraduate program, the tuition fee cannot be refunded. Students suspended or dismissed from the program for disciplinary or academic reasons after the start of the program are not eligible for any refund of fees.

In case I am required to apply for a visa and residence permit, I herewith declare that I will take care of all necessary arrangements in a timely manner before the start of the Postgraduate Program. I am aware that the time between my visa application and the receipt of an Austrian visa and residence permit can take up to several months. Furthermore, I am responsible for registering my place of accommodation (residence registration, i.e. "Meldezettel") myself.

The Program Director reserves the right to cancel the Program for compelling reasons before its start. In this case, all tuition fees paid would be refunded. The Program Director reserves the right to make necessary changes to the curriculum, to change the venues and make organizational changes at short notice.
