## About the training programme

We are pleased to invite you to a training and capacity-building week about the social responsibility of universities and higher education institutions, which will take place in the premises of the University of Vienna, Austria.

The five-day training with approximately 20-30 participants will be held from Monday May 9<sup>th</sup> to Friday May 13<sup>th</sup> 2016, and will involve both input about social responsibility in the university context as well as practical analysis of good practice examples of how universities can manage their social responsibility and have an impact on local businesses, the community and society as a whole.

## Why attend?

Universities have undergone several reform processes in the last years and it is part of the modernization agenda of the EU to promote universities' interaction with other target groups in their city or region. Apart from research and teaching, the universities' profile is re-negotiated now – from "communities of scholars" to "communities of practitioners", who fulfil a social contract, with an excellent performance within science and with an impact on society.

# The UNIBILITY-project

The training is conducted within the Erasmus+ UNIBILITY-project "University Meets Social Responsibility" (2015-2017) – Grant Agreement No.: 2015-1-AT01\_K203-005033, coordinated by the University of Vienna in cooperation with five other higher education institutions and EUCEN:

The UNIBILITY-project wants to develop strategies how universities can actively increase their social responsibility on student and researcher level. In the course of the project, researchers will develop practical service learning projects together with students for the benefit of the local community. The UNIBILITY-project partners will also develop training material for USR, which can be transferred to other universities who want to start engaging in social responsibility as well.

#### Financial reimbursement

Reimbursement of costs: each participant is entitled to 275 € of reimbursement per flight ticket and 500 € for cost of stay for the whole week. This has to be negotiated with your host university. Spaces are limited to max. 5 participants per host university. Please note that costs can only be reimbursed of the participant stays for the whole training programme from Monday until Friday.
